Letter To Readers

The current auction is our unique to the industry affordable autograph, card and memorabilia auction. Covering all of the major sports, this auction consists almost entirely of collectibles with a retail value of \$500 or less and low minimum bids. This particular auction contains a very interesting assortment of autographs, cards and memorabilia from all of the major sports.

Day one is all about baseball autographs as usual. Signed cards come first: we have a pair of 1933 Goudey signed HOFers and a PSA slabbed run of Boston Braves cards from 1933 through 1952 with some tougher signatures. There are many partial signed sets and group lots, and a few very unusual signed cards, including a 1972 Topps Tom Seaver Poster and a 1982 Red Lobster Ryne Sandberg.

We continue with a small but solid run of Perez Steeles and a fine offering of signed Yellow HOF Plaques. These should be of great interest to many of you, as these include the HOFers inducted in the last ten years that are missing from so many sets and runs.

3x5 collectors will see classic HOFers, tougher Negro League signatures and scarcities. There is a wide and eclectic offering of signed 8x10 photos, with classic HOFers, fun multi-signed images, scarcities and many group lots. We have many terrific 1950s and 1960s vintage signed Chicago Cubs programs and other autographed items, these include very early signatures from Ernie Banks and Ken Hubbs.

Autographed baseballs close out day one. We have a broad selection of HOFers, tougher deceased singles and many balls with desirable inscriptions. There are many players here that usually do not appear in our auctions. Single signed balls conclude with a large number of group lots, these are excellent values that are well worth reviewing carefully. Multi-signed baseballs include HOF balls, star signed baseballs and interesting combinations. Team balls go back to the 1930s, with a high quality Minor League vintage team ball collection spread over many lots, quality Cubs team balls from the 1950s and 1960s and more.

Day two opens with baseball cards. This section has some interesting oddball sets, some better unopened items and several terrific 1960s Chicago Cubs test issues and other fine card-related collectibles. There is a solid selection of modern cards, with two quality Aaron Judge cards and other desirable pieces of the top players.

Basketball comes next; there are some simply terrific signed HOF and star signed basketballs, with Red Auerbach, Wilt Chamberlain, Chuck Connors, Tim Duncan and more. We hardly ever see these, there are also many interesting signed flats with classic HOFers.

Football is very well represented in this auction. We have signed cards of key HOFers going back to the 1950s, a solid selection of NFL and College Football HOFers on 3x5s, many of which are slabbed. There are some terrific signed Goal Line Postcards with key HOFers and many desirable signed photos. We have a fine run of signed 16x20s by HOFers and stars, and quality programs dating back to the 1930s.

Hockey collectors will see many tough 3x5s and signed items, with note to Jacques Plante, Terry Sawchuck and a terrific Wayne Gretzky UDA signed 16x20 print.

Baseball memorabilia nicely closes out the auction. There are quality runs of signed and game bats, tickets, programs, pennants, pins and much more.
