The current auction checks in at 1,000 lots and has a tremendous variety of fresh and interesting material. Auction highlights include great pre-war and post-war baseball card singles and sets, a wide variety of unopened boxes across several sports, an amazing non-sport section that checks in at 100 lots, autographs from President Lincoln and other historical autographs, an amazing Cubs collection and some terrific baseball memorabilia.

We open the auction with a gorgeous, completely fresh to the hobby 1939 Joe Cronin Boston Red Sox road flannel jersey that is rated a 9 by MEARS. Additional key auction items include an amazing quartet of the so rare and beautiful M110 Sporting Life Cabinets (Chance, Lajoie, Mathewson, Young). We have a really nice N28 Mike King Kelly SGC 5, 1907 Dietsche Postcard Ty Cobb name on front variation SGC 1, a 1908 Rose Postcard of Addie Joss, a T206 Cobb Bat on Shoulder with a Sovereign 350 back PSA 3, T206 Demmitt SGC 2, O'Hara SGC 1.5 and Young SGC 4.

Key lots continue with a 1921 Exhibit Babe Ruth PSA 2, 1928 Harrington's Ice Cream Babe Ruth SGC 1.5, 1933 George C. Miller Dizzy Dean SGC 3, a pair of 1933 Goudey Lou Gehrigs (PSA 2, SGC 3.5), 1933 Goudey 149 Babe Ruth SGC 5, 1939 Play Ball Ted Williams RC SGC 3, 1948 Leaf Jackie Robinson RC Beckett 2, an amazing PSA 9 1950 Callahan set, 1951 Bowman Mantle PSA 1, Mays PSA 3, 1952 Berk Ross Mantle PSA 3, 1952 Bowman Mantle PSA 5, 1954 Johnson Cookies Aaron RC PSA 7 and a 1958 Hires Root Beer with tab Willie Mays PSA 7.

There is a terrific collector grade 1957 Topps set with slabbed key cards, a 1967 Topps set with 90 slabbed cards, a gorgeous signed 1953 Bowman Color Mickey Mantle, a PSA 8 Jackie Robinson signed HOF postcard, a 1931 Yankees team ball, 1988 Fleer basketball wax box and a 1986 Topps football rack box.

Other items of note include a huge run of Chicago Cubs signed team sets going back to the 1950s, thirteen different Derek Jeter signed cards, mainly signed pre-1995 & a really cool Lou Gehrig autograph. We have several Presidential documents, a Thomas Edison check, 8x10 photos signed by George Harrison and Jim Henson, and even an authentic Elizabeth Taylor signed magazine in our historical and entertainment autograph sections.

Collectors of non-sports cards will see our largest offering ever. 










One of the most interesting and exciting pieces of memorabilia that we have handled, offered is a completely original 1939 Joe Cronin road flannel jersey. Cronin played from 1926 - 1945 and was a HOF shortstop and a future President of the American League. A baseball fixture for over 50 years, anything used by him in a game is very desirable. Graded Mint 9 by MEARS, this is consigned by the original owner and is completely fresh to the hobby. This is an absolutely gorgeous and truly museum worthy piece of baseball history. As a note, Cronin was an All Star in 1939 and was 16th in MVP voting as well. A great, great piece, this is worthy of the finest collections in the hobby.





2 1887 N28 Allen and Ginter Mike King Kelly SGC 5.......2000 One of the greatest superstars in 19th century baseball, this is a cornerstone card for many collectors. Bright and clean, the offered card has a flawless image, vivid color and clean white borders. The corners show light and even wear, the edges are crisp. The back is perfectly clean, which can be the hardest thing to find on these cards. 19th century HOF baseball cards, despite a recent price run-up, still seem like utter bargains in today's market. Great card.











4 1908 Rose Company Postcards Addie Joss PSA Authentic...1800 One of the great postcard issues, these are revered by collectors. Addie Joss is a cult favorite HOFer, making this a particularly special and desirable card. Freshly slabbed and new to the hobby, this was mailed and postmarked in 1908. The condition is in the VG range overall, with corner wear and light creasing, without respect to the mailing. The card retains good color and a fine image. The last two public sales, SGC 3 and 4 respectively, were for \$8,100 and \$21,000. Superb card.

5 1909 T206 Ty Cobb Bat On Shoulder (pop 1/5 in this grade)

PSA 3 (Sovereign 350 back)3000

Offered is a great card given the front and back combination. This card has good color, nice centering and a clean reverse. There is just some very minute corner creasing at the lower right corner and slight general wear. The edges are reasonably crisp, the corners are not bad at all. The card is very solid for a 3, the scarce back displays well.







6 Demmitt (St. Louis)

SGC 2.....2400

One of the absolute keys to a T206 set, these are needed by almost all set collectors. The offered card is a pleasing 2. This card has good color, a nice image and a particularly clean reverse. The card has moderate creasing and corner wear and some general surface wear. Low grade but far from abused, this should be perfect for so many sets, particularly if you do not want to spend a small fortune on a high grade example.

7 O'Hara (St. Louis)

SGC 1.52000

An absolute key to a T206 set, this is often the hardest card to find outside of the big four. The offered card has terrific centering, rich color and a very nice image. The back is very solid, the borders are not bad at all. Alas, creasing keeps this at a 1.5, this card displays very nicely for the grade to our eyes.

8 Young (Cleveland, portrait)

SGC 4.....1500

A vital T206 card and a cornerstone Cy Young card, these are always very desirable. Offered is a solid 4, with no visible creases or wrinkles, even under magnification. The card has clean white borders, rich color and a nice image. The back is clean with some slight print. The corners show mild and consistent wear, this is a really nice 4 to our eyes.





9 1911 M110 Sporting Life Cabinets

Frank Chance (pop 1/6 for all grades)

PSA 2500

One of the great early 20th century cabinet issues, these are just so scarce and hardly ever come to market. Freshly slabbed by PSA, this is simply a great looking card. The larger size is a perfect showcase for a fine color image of HOFer Frank Chance. We cannot see any creasing on the card, the front has clean borders and mild corner wear. The back has some wear from being in a scrapbook or something similar, it is not bad at all and led to the 2 grade. Great card.

10 1911 M110 Sporting Life Cabinets

Nap Lajoie (pop 1/10 for all grades)

PSA 1500

One of the great early 20th century cabinet issues, these are just so scarce and hardly ever come to market. Freshly slabbed by PSA, this is a terrific card of a widely collected player that hardly anyone else has. The front offers a very attractive large color image of Lajoie's classic batting pose; there is some light creasing, the corner wear is not bad at all. The back displays well but has a slight scrape at the top border (and some other wear) that led to the 1 grade. This is a fine looking card for the grade, no doubt it will find a very happy home in the auction!






11 1911 M110 Sporting Life Cabinets

Christy Mathewson (pop 1/7 for all grades)

One of the great early 20th century cabinet issues, these are just so scarce and hardly ever come to market. Freshly slabbed by PSA, this is a terrific card of a the beloved and one-and-only Christy Mathewson. The larger format of the card affords a wonderfully detailed image of Matty's classic pitching pose. The card has good color and nice display value, some general wear on the front is present, along with creasing, the corners are not bad at all. The back also has some general wear, but displays well overall. A card that hardly ever comes to market, this was obtained from us decades ago and has been unknown to the hobby until now. Great card.






12 1911 M110 Sporting Life Cabinets

Honus Wagner (pop 1/10 for all grades)

PSA AA.....1000

One of the great early 20th century cabinet issues, these are just so scarce and hardly ever come to market. Freshly slabbed by PSA, this is a truly rare and super attractive card of the legendary Honus Wagner. The larger size card allows for a wonderfully detailed color image of a very focused Wagner in his classic batting pose. The offered card has a very attractive front, there is hardly any creasing, the corner wear is consistent, the borders are clean. The back is quite clean for the issue, with some very subtle surface wrinkles. Measuring the card in the slab, it looks to measure 5 5/8 x 7 3/8; the Standard Catalog lists the proper top to bottom measurement as 7 1/2 inches, so this is a tiny bit short. The card could well have been cut short, this came from one of the oldest collectors in the hobby, it was obtained in the 1970s or early 1980s. Either way, this is a truly great card of Honus Wagner that has hardly any other examples in circulation (only 10 examples have ever been slabbed by PSA).





13 1921 Exhibit Babe Ruth

PSA 24000

Offered is the most classic of all Babe Ruth Exhibit cards. With a definitive and unique photo of a relatively svelte Babe with his hands on his knees in the field, the picture looks great. An extremely desirable and pricey card, the offered card is solid for the grade. Perfectly centered, this has hardly any creasing. The back has no damage or paper loss, the edges are not bad at all. The corners show typical wear for the grade, the fine image here displays nicely.





14 1928 Harrington's Ice Cream 5 Babe Ruth SGC 1.51500 One of the few relatively affordable cards that picture Mr. Ruth as a pitcher for the Boston Red Sox, this is a cool card. Heavily creased, the image is still nice, the back has no paper loss.

15 1933 George C. Miller Dizzy Dean

SGC 3.....1950

One of the key cards to this white-hot set, these do not come to market very often at all. The most recent public sale was a PSA 5 for \$12,600. Offered is a very attractive and fine looking SGC VG 3 exemplar. Well centeed, this has a perfect image and rich color. The corner wear is mild and consistent, the borders are clean. The back of the card is perfectly clean, extremely subtle surface creasing keeps this at very nice 3.











18 1933 Goudey 149 Babe Ruth

SGC 5.....6000

One of the key cards to this most vital baseball card set, it always so hard to find these cards in Ex 5 quality. The offered card has rich color and a gorgeous image. Centered just about perfect left to right, this has the usual centering to the bottom border. The borders are clean, the back is also bright and clean. Light corner wear is the only issue here, this is a very fine looking example of a classic and key Babe Ruth card.





20 1948 Leaf 79 Jackie Robinson RC Beckett 2.......2500 A vital card of the beloved Jackie Robinson, this is a cornerstone card for many collectors. The offered card is a colorful and attractive lower grade example with no technical flaws. Centered to the left border, the color and imagery on the front are flawless, with no print, registration or other issues. The borders are fine, but there is a fair amount of corner wear and some creasing. The back is perfectly clean save for the same corner wear and creasing as the front.









22 1951 Bowman 253 Mickey Mantle RC PSA 12000 One of the ultimate baseball cards, this one displays beautifully for the grade and should have a wide field of interest. Fairly well centered, this has a strong image, good color and clean borders. There is creasing, but it just barely cracks the paper and cannot be seen on the back. The corner wear is not bad at all. Much, much more like a 2 than a 1, the back is nice, the card is awfully, awfully nice for the grade and no doubt will find a very happy home!







24 1952 Berk Ross 37 Mickey Mantle

PSA 31350


A classic and very uncommon Mickey Mantle second-year card, these are always so popular as they have the same pose as his 1951 Bowman card. Almost always found with major cutting and centering issues, this one displays exceptionally well. The centering is good, the image is flawless, the surfaces are clean. The back looks good, we cannot see any creases or wrinkles. The corner wear is not bad at all, this is an absolutely ideal card for the grade.

25 1952 Bowman 101 Mantle

PSA 51700

Only Mantle's second-year card, these still seem very undervalued right now. Offered is a pleasing and attractive Ex 5 exemplar. Well centered, this has rich color and a fine image. There are no print issues, the back looks good. The corners show only light wear, this is perfect for so many 1952 Bowman sets and Mantle runs.





26 1954 Johnston Cookies 5 Hank Aaron

PSA 72500

A terrific Rookie Card of the legendary Hank Aaron, this is such a cool and fun card. Slightly oversize, the offered card has outstanding color and a flawless image. The surfaces are pristine, the corners are all quite sharp. The back looks great, slight centering to the right border keeps this at an awfully, awfully sharp 7, great card.

28 1958 Hires Root Beer with tab Willie Mays

PSA 71200

One of the coolest Willie Mays cards, these are so great to see when held in hand. Usually found in very low quality or with miscutting issues, the offered card has outstanding centering. The corners are super sharp, the color is terrific, the image is flawless, the back as well. Something you hardly ever see, this is simply a gorgeous Near Mint 7 overall.





One of the most popular sets of the 1950s, these are beloved by so many collectors. A nice mid-grade set, this one is notable as the Mantle, Koufax and Brooks Robinson cards are all 5s or 5.5s, this hardly ever occurs on these types of sets. The cards are really nice overall, with notably good overall centering. Perhaps 30% of the set is Ex-Mt or better, it could be a little more, nearly all of the remaining cards are Ex or very close to Ex, this is a really nice set.






29 1967 Topps Complete Set w/90 SGC Graded Key Cards A superb set put together by an engineer, these are seriously sharp and clean cards. We will have an exact listing of the slabbed cards on our website. Every card is in a Card Saver for protection, it fills up 2 two-row boxes. A gorgeous set, it looks to be about 70-75% Near Mint or better, the balance is almost all Ex-Mt, generally sharp but off-center. The high number run is very nice, no doubt this set will have a big breakdown value as single cards. There are four 9s, thirteen 8.5s, nineteen 7.5s, twenty-one 7s, eleven 6.5s and four 6s. A very difficult set to assemble in this quality, this is among the most popular of all 1960s Topps sets and would make an outstanding addition to any quality vintage card collection.








30 1953 Bowman Color 59 Mickey Mantle

A gorgeous example of this forever classic Mickey Mantle card, the autograph placement could not be any better! The signature is rated an 8 by PSA, it is in flawless blue sharpie ink and contrasts perfectly against the clean card. Remarkably well centered, this is a truly visually striking card that will stand out in a crowd! The back is clean, the card itself has a fine surface crease by the upper left corner, it would likely grade a 3.5 or a 4.









Crucially, this is signed by Lincoln at the lower right, a solid signature graded a conservative 7 by PSA and by Secretary of War Stanton at the bottom center. It is amazing how these things can sell for less than a Babe Ruth autographed photo. It would seem that this would be an absolutely ideal item to put in a closet for a few years and see if the market calibrates over time to reflect real historical value. PSA DNA (full).

1887-1889 N172 Old Judges

- 38 Thomas Flood Hands at chest PSA 2 mk.............90 St. Joseph's player, this has a slightly light but pleasing image. The wear is not bad at all, some stray writing on the otherwise pretty clean back led to the qualifier.
- 39 Jim Powell (Mgr, Bat 90 Degrees) SGC 2 180 A card we hardly ever see, this might be scarce. The image is strong, the back is fine, general wear keeps this at a 2. Please note the Old Judge manager cards are always very hard to find.

- 42 1899 M101-1 Bobby Wallace RC Beckett 2.5....... 450 A very cool oversize 19th century HOF Rookie Card, these hardly ever come to market. Full size with a superb large format image, I love the detailed biographies and graphics on the back. The edges are nice, as are the surfaces, wear by the top border keeps this at a very attractive 2.5. How often do these come around?

43 1904 Rotograph Postcard

New York Giants (Carl Horner image) SGC 2.5..... 420 Offered is a gorgeous postcard celebrating the 1904 Champion New York Giants (they famously did not play in the World Series as manager John McGraw did not respect the then upstart American League!). The imagery looks great, this has a minute chip at the upper left corner and wear at the lower left. Unmailed, the back looks great, the surfaces are clean. Something that you just never see, the HOFers include Mathewson at the upper left corner and McGraw naturally in the center. Good piece.

- 47 Brown (Portrait)

 A very popular and elusive T206 HOF portrait, these have exploded in price in recent years. The offered card is oversize, with remarkable color. The borders are white, the back looks great, the corner wear is very mild and consistent.

 A slight crease keeps this at a 3, the card looks terrific.

Chicago Cubs Team Beckett 3.......... 100 Scarce as these took up two pages, they are often found separated and with severe condition issues. Creatively slabbed by Beckett, this just shows some light corner wear and looks terrific. With several HOFers and stars, this is really nice and a condition rarity in this quality.
