

# Letter To Readers

Our current auction is the always super popular \$5 reserve vintage card auction. This one is all about baseball cards, mainly pre-1960. The auction features several fresh collections and a very eclectic mix of star cards, Rookie Cards, type-cards, scarcities and value lots.

The auction offers an amazing 451 different lots of pre-war baseball cards! This section begins with a trio of 19th century cards and continues with a W600 Johnny Kling, several slabbed 1907 Dietsche Tigers postcards, a pair of 1908 era Cubs postcards and two 1907 Grignon Cubs postcards.

Pre-war continues with a 1907 H.M. Taylor Tigers Hughie Jennings, a 1907 Novelty Cutlery Dooin and a run of slabbed E90-1 American Caramels with many HOFers. The auction has an amazingly detailed vintage Chicago Cubs collection from a long-time and wonderful hobbyist spread throughout the auction, but especially from before 1940.

We have some tougher 1910 era E cards, T3 Turkey Reds in collector grade, a pair of T5 Pinkerton Postcards, a run of T202 Triple Folders, 1913 Tom Barkers, 1914 T213 Type 2s, T222 Fatimas and a big selection of graded 1921 Exhibit cards with many HOFers.

Pre-war baseball continues with many 1920s cards, including four 1921 Holsum Bread. 1930s collectors will see four 1933 DeLongs, a run of collector grade 1933 Goudeys with many HOFers, 1934-6 Diamond Stars, 1934 Goudeys with lower grade key cards, clean 1935 R310s and 1936 R311s and some tougher Salutation Exhibit cards.

Post-war baseball includes many collector grade examples of key cards. In particular, there is a 1951 Bowman Mays RC SGC 1, 1953 Topps Mantle PSA 1, Paige PSA 3.5 and Mays PSA 3. Other key cards include 1954 Topps Aaron RC PSA 1.5, 1954 Bowman Ted Williams VG, a pair of 1955 Bowman Mantles, 1955 Topps Clemente and Koufax PSA 3 Rookies, 1956 Topps Mantle PSA 1.5 (white back), 1957 Topps Brooks Robinson RC SGC 5.5, 1959 Topps Gibson RC SGC 4, 1960 Topps Mantle SGC 5 and a 1967 Topps Seaver RC PSA 5.

Our full sale section features a broad offering of signed baseballs, HOF plaques, Perez Steele signed photos and 8x10 signed photos. Pre-war baseball includes a deep selection of slabbed T206s with many HOFers, scarcities and Southern Leaguers, a wide offering of T205 Gold Borders, many new 1920s slabbed cards with HOFers and many 1930s gum cards with slabbed HOFers.

We have new additions throughout oddball baseball, including Berk Ross, Bazooka and Stand Ups.

Topps and Bowman collectors will see a large number of 1966 and 1967 Topps high numbers, new stars from most of the 1950s sets, including key Mantle PSA and SGC slabbed cards, Clemente Rookies and much more.

We have a nice selection of vintage football and basketball cards, please note there are far more of these on our online store.

We conclude the catalog with a solid offering of 1890 Mayo Boxing, 1951 Ringside boxing and a selection of vintage hockey cards, again there are many, many more on our online store.

Arlie Latham (Brownie's Champions) SGC 1  
Neat Old Judge subset, the condition here is unfortunately extremely rough.

2 1887 N172 Old Judge  
Bill Vinton Pitch, hands at chest PSA AA  
Rebacked, this has an outstanding image.

3 1890 H804-1 Tobin Lithograph  
Baby Anson Oh Mamma! PSA 1.5 mk  
19th century trade card with this premier HOFer, this is definitely an oddball card! A key card in this genre, this is full size with rich color. Creasing keeps this at a 1.5, some other issue led to the qualifier, the back has no paper loss, which is very unusual for this issue.

Johnny Kling  
A revered issue, this has a terrific image. Noticeably trimmed at the top border, the other borders look alright. The back has one section of mounted paper, it is otherwise clean. A card that you just never see, this should be a very popular lot.

6 1904 W601 Holyoke  
Full size with no rips or tears, there is just one slight stain.

7 1905 Mutt and Jeff Oh You Cubs VG+  
Tough type-card, this is very clean for the issue.

Interesting item, these are both large format seven by just over five inch postcards. Sepia toned, these display very well. They are both neatly mounted onto a scrapbook page, we did not attempt to remove them.

Mailed, this has period notations in the bottom margin. Fun and affordable early 20th century postcard, this has HOFers Tinker, Evers, Chance and Brown.

Very tough issue, this is unmailed and displays well. There is a fine crease on the front that can be felt but not seen, the card has some light edge wear and is very nice for the grade.

Unmailed, this has a very clean front, wear in one portion of the back keeps this at a 3.

Pleasing 3, this has moderate corner wear and hardly any creasing, the back is fine.

Solid mid-grade card, the corner wear is consistent, the back is fine, we do not see any creasing.

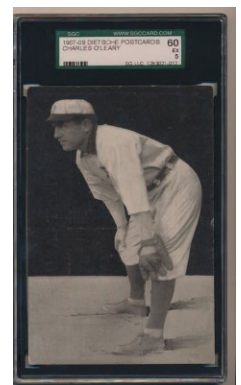
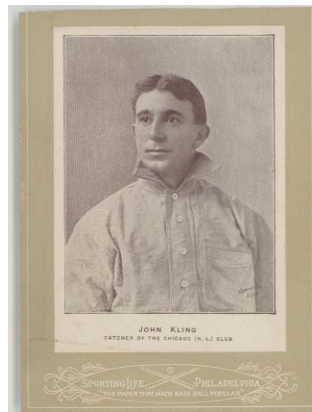

With period notations on the back, this has rich color and a nice image. Corner wear and edge wear, mainly in one spot, keep this at a 2 mk.

Star pitcher, a near-HOFer, this is a tough and desirable card. An extremely attractive postcard issue, these are not easy to find in 3 holders. The offered cards has very clean surfaces, rich color and no visible creases. The corner wear is mild and consistent, this is awfully nice for a 3.

Hughie Jennings PSA 1.5  
Uncommon and desirable postcard issue, this has a terrific photo. Unmailed and rather clean overall, a slight crease of some sort by the top center appears to be the only real issue here.

An extremely attractive postcard issue, these have a great design. The offered card has a terrific image. Graded Authentic due to writing on the back, the front is clean, with just one tiny nick by the top border, there are no creases, the image is strong. The grading services are funny with giving written postcards numerical grades, we believe this card to be fully original in all respects.

Well centered and nice, wear at the very top of the back appears to be the only real flaw here.

Uncommon card, this has a fine image and good color. Well centered with a clean back, corner wear appears to be the only issue here, we do not see any creases or wrinkles.

Well centered with rich color, the corner wear is not bad at all, the back has one slight stain by the lower left corner.

Neat card, this has terrific color. Centered to the top border, there is hardly any creasing, the back is fine, the corner wear is mild and consistent.

Well centered with superb color and a superb image, we do not see any creasing. There is slight wear in one spot on the back, the card displays well.

Rougher 2, this has a fair amount of corner wear and some creasing.

Colorful card, this has some creasing and general wear. The back has some general wear, but no paper loss.

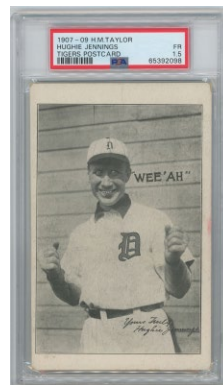

Well centered with rich color, the card has mild creasing and a clean back.

Fairly well centered with rich color, this is a clean card. We cannot see any creases or wrinkles, the back is solid.

Centered to the left border, the image looks great, this has light creasing, the back is fine.

Colorful card, corner wear keeps this at a 2.
