

Letter To Readers

Checking it at 945 lots, this catalog features one of the strongest \$5 reserve card auctions that we have offered.

The auction begins with some interesting early 20th century postcard issues, including 1907 Dietsche Cubs, 1907 H.M. Taylor and Wolverine Postcards. We have some clean slabbed T206 commons, a run of collector grade T202 Triple Folders, better 1914 B18 Blankets, five scarce 1916-1920 Big Head strip cards and some clean 1917 Boston Stores and E135 Collins McCarthys. There are also some high grade 1923 WG7 Walter Mail cards and many 1920s strip cards.

1930s baseball collectors will see a run of collector grade 1933 DeLongs with HOFers, 1933-1934 Goudeys and Diamond Stars. One high spot of the auction is a terrific offering of 1935 – 1941 Wheaties baseball cards. Extremely attractive and undervalued cards, these look so much nicer in hand than on a web site or printed catalog. Loaded with HOFers, there are two Lou Gehrigs and four Joe DiMaggios among so much more. 1930s cards close out with two 1939 Play Ball Joe DiMaggios. We have collector grade 1940 Play Balls and 1941 Goudeys with a 1940 Joe DiMaggio.

Postwar baseball collectors will see a very extensive offering of Mickey Mantle cards from 1952-1967. These are freshly graded cards, many of which present much nicer than their technical grade. Highlights of this section include 1948 Bowman Berra RC PSA 2, 1948 Leaf Joe DiMaggio PSA 2, two terrific 1949 Bowman group lots, 1951 Bowman Ted Williams PSA 5 and also two great group lots. We continue with a 1952 Berk Ross Joe DiMaggio PSA 2, 1952 Topps cards in various grades up to PSA 7 and two good common lots. 1953 Bowman Color collectors will see an extensive offering with key stars and clean commons as single lots. We have collector grade examples of key cards 1953 Topps Mantle and Mays, 1954 Bowman Mantle, 1954 Topps Banks, Kaline Rookies, 1955 Bowman Mantle and Aaron, 1955 Topps Koufax RC, 1956 Topps Mantle, 1957 Topps Mantle and 1958 Topps Mantle.

There are near-sets from 1958 and 1959 Topps loaded with stars. 1960s Topps collectors will see 1960 Topps Mantle PSA 4, 1961 Topps Mantle PSA 5 and Mantle AS PSA 5, 1962 Topps Uecker RC PSA 7 and many very clean 1963 Topps PSA 7s including Mantle, Killebrew and other stars.

The auction closes with very near sets of 1969 and 1970 Topps baseball and a smattering of clean 1960s and 1970s basketball and football cards.

 2 1889 ER Williams Batter Out on Fly VG+

 New York Yankees (Highlanders) Good
 Good item as this has a very early image of Jack Chesbro. Nicely framed, this has water damage but otherwise displays reasonably well. The other two HOFers present are Wee Willie Keeler and Clark Griffith (oddly enough his name is misspelled; total size 15x15).

- 4 1906 Fan Craze Clark Griffith PSA 3
 Very attractive card, a faint crease keeps this at a 3. I love the portrait images in the set, this is a very early Yankee HOF card.

- 5 1907 Dietsche Cubs Johnny Evers SGC 2
 Very tough and underrated issue, these are so much less common than the Tigers cards. Unmailed card has a fine image and a nice back, there are no creases or wrinkles. Layering at the upper left corner led to the 2 grade.

- 6 1907 Dietsche Cubs Patrick J. Moran SGC 2
 Scarce and undervalued issue, there are no creases, this has not been mailed. The corners mainly show wear at the top, there is one area of wear on the otherwise clean back.

- 7 1907 Dietsche Cubs Harry Steinfeldt SGC 2
 Scarce and undervalued issue, this card has a great novel image. There is a small chip at the lower left corner, this is otherwise quite clean and displays very well.

 Well centered with great color, this has moderate creasing. Mailed, this is a charming issue.

 Fun and desirable postcard of this charismatic HOFer and future attorney, you have to love the image. Postmarked in 1904, this is otherwise clean and has a charming period feel to it.

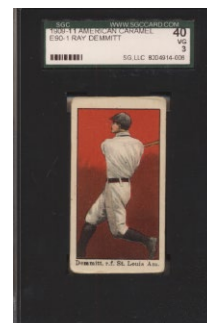

Lot of 8 different w/Cicotte

Low grade lot of these very popular cards, the key Eddie Cicotte card comes in the lot. The other cards are: Hoffman, Krause, Lord, Maddox, McIntyre, Morgan and Wiltse. Three cards have back damage, the Cicotte has chipping on the right border. The fronts tend to be colorful and clean, with honest corner wear and no technical flaws. This is a somewhat substantial lot from a great issue.

Not bad at all, this has good color and consistent corner wear.

25 Bay SGC 3
Bright and attractive Southern Leaguer, this has great color. Slight creasing and corner wear keep this at a 3, the back is quite clean.

26 Bresnahan (with bat) SGC 2
Colorful card is well centered with a nice back and hardly any creasing. Corner wear keeps this at a 2.

27 Ellam SGC 3
Very clean with no visible creases or wrinkles, this is a very nice Southern Leaguer. The corners show very mild wear, this might be a grade too low.

28 Freeman PSA 4
Crisp card has superb color, a great image and four square corners. Wear at the lower right corner keeps this at a 4.

30 Kleinow (Boston) PSA 4 (Polar Bear)
Desirable and scarce variation, these are missing from many sets. The offered card is well centered with a fine looking Polar Bear back. Moderate corner wear keeps this at a 4.

33 Leiffield (pitching) SGC 6
Lovely card has a great image, the corners come to points, the borders are nice and white.

34 Magee (portrait) SGC 3
Solid 3 is well centered with a fine image, hardly any creasing and even corner wear. The back is clean.

35 Maloney SGC 5
Ideal 5, this has outstanding centering and great color. The borders are white, very mild and consistent corner wear keeps this at a 5.

36 Molesworth SGC 2.5
Southern Leaguer, this has some general wear and just one fine surface crease.

37 Oberlin PSA 4
One of my favorite T206s, this card is noted for it's color and image. The offered card has no visible creases or wrinkles, surface wear by the left edge keeps this at a 4.

38 O'Brien GAI 4.5
Soft card has no creases or wrinkles and appears to be fully original. Centered to the upper left corner, there is wear at one spot by the border.

39 Shaughnessy SGC 3
Cult favorite card, this has superb color and a terrific image. Slight creasing and corner wear keep this at a very attractive 3.

41 Stephens SGC 4.5
Cut to the bottom border, this has rich color and a terrific image. There are no creases or wrinkles, the corner wear is moderate.

Southern Leaguer. This has good color. There is a very slight crease by the lower left corner and flicks of wear on the front.

Tougher back, this has slight creasing and rich color. The back looks good, corner wear keeps this at a 3.

Clean lot of M101-2s, all are neatly mounted onto black pages. The fronts are clean, and are as follows: Mack, Schulte, Speaker & Walsh.

Colorful 3 has no center crease and rich color. Centered to the left, this has one nick in the top border.

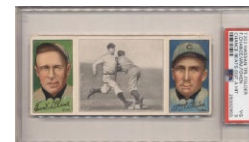
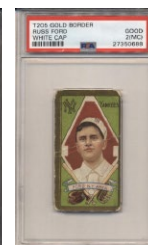
58 Bush Just Misses Austin (Magee, Moran) PSA 3
Very well centered with a clean center panel, a fine crease by one edge and corner wear keep this at a very nice 3.

59 Caught Asleep off First (Bresnahan, Harmon) PSA 4
Well centered with good color, fine creasing keeps this at an attractive 4.

60 Chance Beats Out A Hit (Chance, Foxen) PSA 3
Very well centered with a clean center panel and no creases, the images looks great. Corner wear, mainly at the upper right, keeps this at a 3.

61 Chance Beats Out A Hit (Chance, Shean) PSA 2
Fairly well centered with a clean front, the images look good. Pinprick areas of wear on the reverse keep this at a 2.

62 Chase Dives Into Third (Clarke, Gibson) PSA 3
Solid 3 has a clean center panel and bright white borders. Centered to the top border, there is hardly any creasing.

63 Chase Gets Ball Too Late (Egan, Mitchall) PSA 4
Well centered with no visible creases or wrinkles, corner wear keeps this at a 4.

64 Grant Gets His Man (Grant, Hoblitzell) PSA 3
Well centered with rich color, this is not bad at all, a crease on Grant's card keeps this at a 3.

65 Hal Chase Too Late (McLean, Suggs) PSA 3
Centered to the right border, this has rich color and one fine crease.

66 Moriarity Spiked (Stanage, Willett) PSA 3
Well centered and clean overall, we cannot see any creases. A stain at the lower left corner may have led to the 3 grade.

67 Stone About to Swing (Schulte, Sheckard) PSA 5
Sharp card has four strong corners and super bright white borders. The bottom cut is slightly angular, this otherwise may have come back a 6 or 7.

68 Sullivan Puts Up a High One (Gray, Groom) PSA 2
Not bad at all, a moderate center panel crease keeps this at a 2.

69 The Athletic Infield (Hauser, Konetchy) PSA 4
Sharp card has four strong corners and bright white borders. Cut to the lower right corner, this appears to be the only issue here.

70 Ty Cobb Steals Third (Cobb, Jennings) SGC 1.5
A key to the set, these seem almost criminally undervalued compared to what his much more common T206s trade at. The offered card has three terrific quality images and outstanding color. The corners come to points, this is cut to the bottom border. Moderate creasing in the center panel and wear on the left edge on the back led to the 1.5 grade. This is the kind of card that presents so much nicer than it's technical grade. It will be interesting to see if the market corrects itself on this great card in a few years.

Really nice piece, most would grade this Near Mint. I love the uniform, the photo portion is quite clean, as is the pennant. This is perfect for a high-end type-card collection.

119 Charles Comiskey Ex st
A key figure in baseball history, this has clean edges but there is a stain on his image by the top.

120 Clarence Rowland VG-Ex
White Sox player, the photo has one nick of wear, the pennant itself is vibrant and clean.

121 Vic Saier Ex-Mt+
Very bright and clean, the condition is terrific. The photo looks great, the pennant is very vibrant and fresh, our grade here is conservative.

122 George Stallings Ex-Mt
Bright and clean, the photo and pennant are both strong. Centered a touch to the right border, this displays very well.

1916 Big Head Strip Cards

123 Bagby, Jim PSA 3
It is not easy to get numerical grades from PSA on this very tough issue. A Yankee player, offered is a terrific 3. With wide borders and good color, it is so hard to find these cards like this. Creasing is very minimal, the corners exhibit consistent wear.

124 Burns, George PSA A
Cut right to the image, this has bright color and a clean back. Scarce issue, Yankee player.

125 Cadore, Leon PSA A
Not bad at all, this is a very scarce issue. The borders are reasonable, there is moderate creasing and corner wear. The black back looks great. Tough pre-1920 Yankee card.

126 Mays, Carl PSA A
Neat card with a very funny image, this has respectable borders and no back problems. The image looks good, creasing and corner wear are the issues here. Mays has very few cards, he is a Yankee in this period.

It is not easy to get numerical grades from PSA on this very tough issue. A Yankee player, this has a very amusing and unique image. Mild creasing and corner wear keep this at a 1, we have all seen far worse cards in 1 holders, the back is fine.

Dave Robertson (Herpolsheimer back) Ex-Mt+
Very clean card, the uncommon back looks great. Well centered, this has four solid corners.

129 1916 M101-5 Block & Kuhl
8 Home Run Baker **PSA 2.5**
