The auction continues with a T206 Cobb Bat Off Shoulder PSA 1, T206 Speaker PSA 2 and a T206 Yount Portrait PSA 1.5. We have an M116 Plank PSA Authentic, T3 Chase and McGraw PSA 1 and a T200 Pittsburgh Team Card with Honus Wagner. Other pre-war highlights include several clean 1916 H801-9 Globe Clothing cards, M101-4 Cicotte, clean slabbed W514s and a run of collector grade 1933 Goudey HOFers.

Jack Clements SGC Authentic Affordable example of a revered 19th century issue, the offered card has had the bottom advertising clipped off. The card is otherwise not bad at all, it offers a solid image, has wear over part of the player name and pencil on the back. This is an absolutely ideal card for a type-card collector on a budget as this card would likely otherwise run thousands of dollars.

- 14 1895 Mayo Yale Murphy PSA 1 Bright card has surface wear by the top and bottom border and is centered heavily to the right. Still, this card is more like a 2 than a 1, the back has no issues.
- 15 1895 N300 Mayo Tom Daly PSA 2 Creasing and general wear keeps this at a 2. The back has only one area of wear, the image is generally unaffected by all of this, however. Brooklyn Dodger player.
- 16 1895 N300 Mayo Charlie Ganzel PSA 1 More like a 2, this has a perfectly clean back and no obvious creases. General wear on the front of the card is the only real issue here.

71 57 Duffy PSA 2.5 Popular card has great color and respectable bold borders. Solid for the grade, creasing at the lower right corner appears to be the main issue here. 72 71 Ford (white cap) PSA 2 Tougher variation, this has no creases, but a fair amount of corner wear keeps this at a 2.

Bright, clean and well centered, this is awfully nice for the grade. The gold borders look great, we cannot see any creases. Corner wear at the lower right corner keeps this card at an awfully nice 4.

One of the most attractive T3s, this received a seriously tough grade! Brightly colored with a fine image, the back is clean, there are no pinholes, there are no creases. There are two small nicks at the left border and a very minute scrape in the lower right corner of the frame; cards like this make one hate slabbing!





















77 1912 C46 24 Carl Silton SGC 5 Condition sensitive Minor League issue, these are not easy to find in 5s. Clean card is well centered, slight wear on the right border keeps this at a 5.

78 1912 L1 Leather Ed Walsh Poor Among the most interesting and desirable oversize early 20th century baseball issues, L1 Leathers are revered by collectors. Offered is a low grade example with various condition issues, but still when will you find another one of these? General wear from handling, tears and other condition issues keep this at Poor. The image is still presentable, no doubt this will find a happy home!

79 1912 T207 Brown Border Byrne SGC 4 Well centered with a fine image, mild wear keeps this at a 4.

The image is not bad at all, with slight fading, the surfaces show typical wear, we would grade it Good without respect to the cut. Elusive card, we do not see these very often.

114 1925 W590 Dazzy Vance RC PSA Authentic Scarce card, this is a Rookie card of charismatic Brooklyn Dodger HOF pitcher Dazzy Vance. Slabbed Authentic as it does not have full borders, the card is otherwise not bad at all. There are no creases, corner wear is present, the image is fine, as is the back.

115 1927 Exhibit Rogers Hornsby SGC 2 Pleasing 2 has a nice image on the front and no visible creases. Very elusive card, discoloration on the unmailed reverse led to the 2 grade.


