Letter To Readers

We first want to note that due to rising business expenses and market conditions, we do now have to raise our buyers premium to 22% starting with this auction.

Now to the good stuff! The current auction is one of the most interesting and exciting that we have ever offered. Our combined efforts with Lelands has resulted in a flood of quality material floating between both companies, ending up in the place that best serves the interests of our consignors.

This auction features several amazing collections that are completely fresh to the hobby. There is a phenomenal selection of pre-war baseball cards with many trophy pieces, a solid selection of vintage baseball card sets, fine autographed cards, many top HOFer signed autographs and a quality run of fresh team signed baseballs. Perez Steele collectors will see a freshly slabbed run with PSA rarities.

We picked up a really fun astronaut and cosmonaut autograph collection, there is a fine JFK signed Presidential document and a nice mix of entertainment signed autographs. Non-sport collectors will see many vintage sets, there is a terrific 1950 Bowman football PSA set broken into lots, a terrific collection of C55 and C57 hockey cards and high quality baseball memorabilia, with note to desirable game used bats, tickets, pennants, Brooklyn Dodger memorabilia and more.

The key lots in the auction start with a beautiful 1909 E90-1 American Caramel Shoeless Joe Jackson Rookie Card. With all of the attention surrounding his removal from the banished player list, this might be the ideal time to add this to your collection.

We continue with an N162 King Kelly PSA 1, W600 Frank Chance SGC 1, 1907 Dietsche Cobb SGC 1 Name on Front variation and an E95 Philadelphia Caramel Honus Wagner PSA 1. T206 collectors will see a Walter Johnson PSA 3 with a Tolstoi back and a really nice PSA 1 Magie Error.

Pre-war baseball continues with three Honus Wagner cards: an E90-1 American Caramel PSA 1, E98 Beckett 7 and an E91-C PSA 4. We have the four key cards from the M101-2 Premiums, including the Joe Jackson. Both E106 Ty Cobb cards make an appearance in the auction, followed by a truly rare M101-4 Ware's back PSA 2 Ty Cobb. Babe Ruth collectors will see a rare 1929 Star Player Candy, a pair of 1932 U.S. Caramels, including a super rare cancelled card, as well as the 1933 Goudey run.

1933 Goudey collectors will have a historic opportunty to truly complete their set with a 1933 Lajoie (PSA 2 mk). The auction also has one of my personal all-time favorite cards, a 1933 Zeenut Joe DiMaggio Throwing (PSA 1.5). A 1948 Leaf Jackie Robinson PSA 4 follows, there is a 1955 Stahl-Meyer Mickey Mantle and an autographed 1953 Bowman Color Mickey Mantle.

Key lots conclude with an Albert Pujols PSA 10 signed game used bat, a 1911 C55 Hockey Set, all PSA graded, and a really nice SGC 4.5 1966 Topps Bobby Orr Rookie Card.







Immortalized in film, he is one of the most popular players in all of baseball history. Now eligible for the Hall of Fame, this would seem be a near certainty in the coming years. Offered is one of his most valuable and iconic cards, the 1909 E90-1 American Caramel.


Purchased from us in the 1990s before slabbing, this card is completely fresh to the hobby. Slabbed at the National, this beautiful card received a fair share of oohs and aahs from those to whom we showed it off! Well centered, the front of the card has rich color and clean white borders. The corners are in the VG-Ex range. The image displays very well, with more than respectable registration. The back of the card has a small scrape by the upper right corner, hence the 1.5 grade. An important card that will not run into the hundreds of thousands of dollars due to that minute back scrape, now would seem like an ideal time to pick one of these before his likely HOF Induction and flood of publicity. - A vital 19th century player, this is one of his most desirable cards. From a revered set, these still seem like such bargains in light of what key modern cards trade at. The offered card has good color and a nice image. The back has some light scraping and wear, but is not bad at all. The main issue with the card are some surface scrapes by the top right portion of the front. The front is otherwise crease-free and fairly clean. While this card certainly is fairly graded, some might prefer this to something that has a ton of creases, faded color and just all kinds of general wear as is the case for most 1s from this set that come to market.

A key to an important set, the offered card is notable for rich color and a particularly well defined, registered and contrasted image. Centered to the left border, the corners nearly come to points and are very sharp for the grade. The card exhibits very subtle toning, the back is clean. We do not see any creases or wrinkles, even under magnification.

The card truly displays well above a 4, this will be a cornerstone card for many collectors.









A vital Topps set, offered is a low grade but still very appealing set. The cards vary in grade, perhaps 65% GVG to VG, the balance lower. The lower cards cards tend to retain respectable eye appeal, these are not ugly or destroyed cards by any stretch of the imagination. The high number run is pretty nice for a set in this grade, but there is condition variance there as well. The set does have cleaner cards scattered about. The three key cards, while low grade, all display well.






One the neatest and coolest of all Mickey Mantle oddball issues from the 1950s, these are revered by collectors. The Art Ross card is well centered with rich color. A fair amount of corner wear, and some general surface wear keep it at a 1.5. The back is clean, the card displays very nicely for the grade. The Vezina card has terrific color and strong centering. The corner wear is mild and consistent. The back has some fine creasing that does not crack the paper, this displays very well for the grade. This set came from a mini-find of these we had in the 1990s, and has been tucked away in a box until now.

Produced for the 1908 World Series between the Cubs and the Tigers, this has vivid color imagery of a game in progress. The postcard has been mailed, some creasing is present. The surfaces are clean overall, this retains outstanding eye appeal and is just a terrific pre-1910 World Series postcard.

A very popular card, this is now especially interesting as Cicotte may become a HOFer in the future. An extremely attractive card with a wonderful image, this is a freshly slabbed and very attractive 3. Well centered with only slight creasing, the back is clean. 

- 57 Mathewson (dark cap) PSA 2.5 (Old Mill)...... 200 An absolute top T206 HOFer, it is never easy to find players of this caliber with a better back. The offered card has gorgeous color, a beautiful image and solid centering. There is just one fine crease, the borders are white, the corners are fine. The back is clean, fine card.
- Mathewson (white cap) PSA 3 (Sovereign back) .. 500 An absolute top T206 HOFer, it is never easy to find players of this caliber with a better back. The offered card has gorgeous color, a beautiful image and solid centering. The borders are white, the corners are more than fine for the grade. Some creasing is present in the center of the card, but it does not crack the paper, and the back is barely affected. A very fine card for the grade, the scarce Sovereign 150 back provides from a truly superb combination here!
- 59 McCormick (Carolina Brights) SGC 1.5 225 A super desirable back, these are missing from even very advanced T206 collections. The offered card has no visible creases, the surfaces are clean. Miscut, this shows much more on the front than the back. The Carolina Brights back is quite clean and fine, this displays really well and is perfect for a T206 back run.

The offered lot is slightly miscut to the top border, hence the Authentic rating. We do not see any creasing, the color is vibrant, the image is really nice, the borders are clean. The back looks good, the red ink is clearly missing on Sweeney's hat.
